




This is to certify that J W Atchison - surveyor did on the 4th and  
following days of June 1823, by order of William Kirscher and John G. Blair owners  
of the improved, within said Plat so surveyed and stated and located in the Town of  
Towner, Dunn County Wis, said land so surveyed and plat laid as described as  
follows: A part of Government unappropriated lands 6 and 7 Section 16 Township 22  
N R 12 West of the 4th Meridian of Wisconsin. Further described as follows: And beginne  
at or first set at the 1/4 Section corner on the East side of Section 16 - E 29 N 12 W. Then  
South on the East line of Section 16 - E 29 N 12 W 4 585 rods to water works as shown on the Plat  
Then westerly following the water works with the easterly line of the houses of winter habitants on  
the Red Cedar River flowing to the Southeast corner of lot 37 Black 2. Thence North 80 degrees West 1,277 feet,  
Then due West 17-325 1/2 to center of Highway. Thence E 52 degrees S 34 degrees E 305 ft. Then W  
65 degrees S 15 degrees E 1,250 ft. Then N 45 degrees E 320 ft. Then S 55 degrees E 305 ft. Then N  
Section line then East on 1/4 Section line 700 ft. Then South 45 degrees E 420 ft. Then S 56 degrees E 305 ft. Then E  
Then N 30 degrees S 345 ft. Then North 315 ft. Then South 105 ft. to place of beginning. This description includes Blocks  
1 and 2. Description 2: Block 3. Beginning at 1/4 Section corner 1820ft West of 1/4 Sec. corner and South 35 degrees West  
West 620 ft. 3 to Street 60 ft. set as place of beginning - Block 3 is 10 rods wide extending 10 rods North  
Width 60 ft. extended down to the water mark of Big River. Thence North and Northeastly running to water works  
about east North East corner of lot 37 Black 2. Thence South 21 degrees E 2,300 ft. to place of beginning. The 1,250 ft. as survey  
and made said Plat so surveyed and stated and made the within Plat - that the Plat is 7 rods Survey. Shall  
be deducted and known as FIVE - NICKEL - FORT and is an addition to the town of Towner, Dunn County, Wis.  
and the justed land is the 0.5 Gen - 1/4 Section corner at place of beginning that all lots and parcels are of the  
size and the Streets can allow the width marked on the Plat and the width 1/10 Blocks 3 blocks 3 lots
